Data Builder Unveils Expanded Jobsite Document Capture at IRMI's International Risk Management Conference

San Diego – October 9, 2006 – Data Builder, Inc., a leading provider of data management software and services for the Building Industry, today unveiled its expanded document capture software from the International Risk Management Institute (IRMI) 2006 Construction Risk Conference. Data Builder's "Scan to Electronic Project Control System (e-PCS)" software now includes capture and distribution of paper documents from multiple brands of network attached digital copiers and scanners. Construction and facilities management firms now can use e-PCS document management software to more easily manage paper-based information, an important aspect of improving business processes and reducing risk of claims against projects.

Through a partnership with eCopy, Data Builder users can electronically capture and store paper documents in e-PCS using Canon, Gestetner, HP, Konica Minolta, Lanier, Ricoh, Savin, Sharp, and Toshiba network attached copiers and some TWAIN-based scanners. e-PCS users simply place the documents in the feeder and press "Scan to e-PCS" on the copier touch panel. Users are then asked to sign into Data Builder e-PCS with their user name and password, allowing them to file the now electronic document directly into any e-PCS folder for which they have access authority.

Scott Lombard, vice president of Sales and Marketing at Data Builder, was on hand to demonstrate the ease of use of the new software and noted, "We have jobsites that are basically paperless. Once a paper document is received, it is immediately scanned and the electronic workflow begins in e-PCS. By nature, project teams in the construction industry are in multiple locations and equipment may vary per jobsite. Supporting multiple copier and scanner manufacturers allows us to expand data capture capabilities for our users while leveraging our clients' existing equipment."

Crucial to risk management best practices is managing the information trail whether you are in the field or in an office. According to Michael O'Neill, executive vice president-Risk Management Services of American Contractors Insurance Group (ACIG), "As the cost of materials, labor, and claims litigation in the construction industry continue to rise, we must continue to look for ways to limit risk, reduce loss, and maintain profitability. From an industry perspective, timely communication, as well as maintaining organized project records, is a significant factor in achieving these goals. Through successful document management, contractors will both reduce the chance of major claims on a construction project and immediately put them in a position to defend against any claim that may arise."

Data Builder e-PCS is currently used on many ACIG-insured projects. O'Neill adds, "Data Builder provides the technological solutions the construction industry has been looking for to cut project costs and lower claim expenses. The "Scan to e-PCS" integration with eCopy is just one example of Data Builder bringing increased ROI not only to their client's e-PCS investment, but also to their existing digital copier as well."
